RISK ASSESSMENT Covid-19 Guidelines

In order to protect our players and maintenance staff whilst attending the bowls club it is necessary to advise you of the following guidelines which are also part of our overall risk assessment document and we would ask you to strictly adhere to whilst we are still under government Lockdown rules.

Parking: Please ensure that before any game commences that one of the players ensures that the main gate to the car park is closed and that the last person departing after each game also ensures that the gate is closed. This is necessary in order to prevent members of the public believing that the Poplars is open for general use.

Clubhouse: The club house is to be kept locked at all times.

Equipment Shed: This is to be kept locked at all times and the mats and Jacks ONLY will be left available for use during matches.

Attendance: Only those members who have booked to play matches via the booking system operated by Michelle Price-Horne are allowed to attend the green and only at their allotted times as notified on the booking schedule which will be forwarded to you on a weekly basis. NO spectators are permitted to attend.

Bowls: You must only use your own bowls. No others should be used for any reason.

Social Distancing: Matches to be played under the guidelines issued with the Lockdown Draw rules.

Hand Shaking Etiquette: No hand shaking either before or after matches.

Mats/Jacks: Mats are to be sprayed with sanitiser (provided) and jacks to be wiped with sanitising cloth (provided) before and after each match.

Toilets: Will be kept unlocked to minimise handling of locks and hand sanitiser will be provided for use in each toilet.. 'Sanitising wipes are provided for each user to wipe all parts of the sanitary fixtures after use. The used wipes and wet paper towels must be placed in plastic bags provided, removed and taken away for disposal at home. They must not be left at the Poplars.

Handles/ Locks: Must be wiped with sanitising wipes before and after each use.
